

LIVING ON PURPOSE.

REMEMBER: A PURPOSE WITHOUT A PLAN IS JUST A DREAM. BETTER HOPE YOU DON'T WAKE UP.

1. Tell the Lord that you want your purpose to be His purpose for you. Tell Him you do not want to be guilty of asking Him to bless your sense of purpose. Say to Him, "Lord, You may do with me as You will. At the end of the day, I want only to have done Your will."

2. List your life purposes (mother/student/employee/leader/teacher/Christian/etc.). If these seem like roles or tasks instead of purposes, you can look at them in a better way.

3. Identify the purpose in #2 that seems most pressing to you now. (This could be the one for which you have or feel that you should have the most heart or interest.)

4. What training could you seek? (Classes at church, counseling, books, Google)
 - Set some action steps or goals.

 - Find someone who can disciple you into purposeful living.

5. Do you believe that perseverance (pressing on) is a major part of realizing every plan (God's or man's)?
